### SafeCareBC Looking for Front-Line Workers to join our Communications Team

As the province's health and safety leader for the Long-Term Care sector, SafeCareBC is constantly seeking to provide relevant and high quality health and education training to the long-term care sector through a combination of online resources, in-person workshops and on site consultations.

To support this work and ensure our efforts to better connect with front-line workers, SafeCareBC is planning to establish a Communications Working Group of care aides, nurses and service staff.
