Mandatory Rapid Testing for Nonvaccinated Staff

Important Reminder: Rapid Testing and Proof of Vaccination Effective September 16, 2021

Commencing September 16, 2021, any staff who are not yet fully vaccinated (seven days past Dose 2 of the COVID-19 vaccine) are required to undergo rapid testing for COVID-19 prior to every shift worked, in accordance with the Provincial Health Officer's COVID-19 Vaccination Status Information and Preventive Measures Order. Mask use continues to be required for all staff regardless of vaccination status.

As you know, facilities including Menno Place have been confirming vaccination status for staff through the system set out under the PHO's Order. While considerable progress has been made to verify vaccination status for staff throughout the province, the verification process for Menno Place staff is not yet complete.

On a temporary basis, pending our receipt of full verification of vaccination status records for staff through the Provincial Health Officer, you may provide your proof of vaccination directly to the screener to be exempt from the rapid testing requirement. To do so, please bring your proof of vaccination with you for any shifts on or after September 16, 2021. To be fully vaccinated and exempt from the rapid testing requirement, you must be seven days past Dose 2.
